

MRS. CHARLES E. GRANT DIES

Mrs. Charles E. Grant died at the Hubbard Memorial Hospital, Bad Axe on Tuesday. Mrs. Grant had been in the hospital about two weeks following a fall when she fractured her hip.

Mary Elizabeth Graves was born in Alborough township, Elgin, County, Canada on August 2, 1843. She was united in marriage with Charles E. Grant on March 22, 1860. They came to this state and settled on a farm in this township in 1863. Mr. Grant died in 1921.

Deceased is survived by one daughter Mrs. Fred Ruby, of Winsor township; three sons C. V. Grant, of Independence, Mo; J. B. Grant, of South Carolina and George M. Grant of Owendale; also twenty-five grand children and thirty-one great grand children.

The funeral service will be conducted in the L. D. S. church, Bay Port, today and the remains laid to rest in the Old Bay Port cemetery.
